## North Centennial Manor Update – December 15, 2021

### Enhanced measures effective immediately (December 15, 2021) until further notice:

#### 1. Vaccination Status and visits

- a. Vaccination status and important dates:
  - i. **Effective December 15, 2021** -all visitors must provide proof of full vaccination (all doses and a 2-week waiting period after the last dose) to enter the Manor
  - ii. **Effective December 20, 2021** – all essential caregivers must have provided proof of a minimum of the first dose of COVID vaccination to enter the Manor
  - iii. **Effective February 21, 2022**- all Essential Caregivers must provide proof of all required doses to be allowed entry into the Manor
- b. This does not apply to those with proof of a valid medical contraindication to vaccination from a physician or NP.
- c. If a resident is at end of life, these restrictions may be waived in consultation with the Charge Nurse, understanding that the unvaccinated individual is restricted to the resident's bedside wearing appropriate PPE at all times observing all required infection prevention and control guidelines.

#### 2. Surveillance Testing

- a. All staff, student, volunteers, caregivers, visitors, support workers will be Panbio tested on the day of their admittance to the Home until further notice
- b. Staff, students, regulated support workers and volunteers will be tested as soon possible upon entry
- c. Caregivers, visitors, and non-regulated support workers must have a negative Panbio test the day of the visit to be allowed entry

#### 3. Visitor/Essential Caregiver Limits

- a. Limit of no more than 2 per resident at any given time indoors
- b. Limit of no more than 4 per resident outside although all outdoor visits are suspended over the winter months
- c. Any resident in isolation for any reason is limited to one vaccinated caregiver who must wear full PPE for the entire visit.
- d. If Manor is in outbreak for any reason – 1 caregiver per resident limit
- e. No further names will be added to any resident's Essential Caregiver list if the resident already has 2 Essential Caregivers listed on Dec 15, 2021. Any resident who does not have 2 Essential Caregivers on their list as of Dec 15, 2021 may add up to a total of 2 Essential Caregivers, provided that all new Essential Caregivers are fully vaccinated.

#### 4. Activities

- a. Cohorting of residents within their own wings
- b. Due to space limitations – only residents will be allowed at Activities until reassessed in the New Year

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## 5. Social Absences

- a. **Overnight social absences are suspended** – residents who go out on social leave overnight will be discharged and will need to go through the re-admission process.
- b. **Day Pass for Social Reasons:**
  - i. not allowed for the unvaccinated resident,
  - ii. currently not allowed for the vaccinated resident, but will be reassessed frequently with consideration of COVID rates in the community.
- c. **Essential medical, compassionate and palliative absences** continue to be allowed with restrictions upon return as follows:
  - i. Resident must be screened upon return at the front door for signs and symptoms and exposure to COVID while out

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Resident will be isolated a minimum of 7 days</li><li>• PCR Swabbing on Day 1 of return</li><li>• PCR Swabbing on Day 7 of return</li><li>• If BOTH swabs negative, resident will be removed from isolation</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Rapid test and PCR test on DAY 3</li><li>• PCR test on day 7</li><li>• No isolation needed unless a resident is positive on any of the tests.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be reminded that all residents in isolation are restricted to one Essential Caregiver who must wear full PPE during the isolation</li></ul>
